

Certified copies

IN BELGIUM

Present the document to the local administration of your residence.

Attention:

- * For minors, the management of schools belonging to the Fédération Wallonie-Bruxelles will take care of making the certified copies.
- * Please note that it is possible to obtain free certified copies at the diploma recognition services of the FWB (by appointment and depending on Covid restrictions) for secondary school diplomas.
- * Note also that NARIC-Vlaanderen does not ask for a certified copy. Simple copies are enough.

ABROAD

Certify by a competent official at the local administration (or town hall) of the country of residence.

Have the signature legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Have the signature of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs legalized by the Belgian Embassy / Consulate. Alternatively, have the Apostille affixed (for countries having signed the Hague Convention).
