

Sworn translations

IN BELGIUM

Have the document translated by a sworn translator.

If the translator's official stamp has been affixed, your document is ready to be used and does not need to be legalized further.

If the translator's official stamp has not been affixed, have the document legalized at the SPF Justice / FOD Justitie, National Register Department.

ABROAD

Have the document translated by a sworn translator.

Have this signature legalized at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (or Apostille for countries that have signed the Convention of The Hague).

Have the signature of the Ministry legalized by the Belgian Embassy or Consulate (not necessary if an Apostille is affixed).

Please note: translations of the *diploma* made abroad are not accepted by NARIC!
